

Bernice points out that concrete vs. vinyl costs are about the same on a vacant lot, but that concrete construction costs way more when

there are houses present.





This is because construction must be done from the waterside, and because of staging issues caused by fewer and fewer vacant lots being available for this purpose on the island.

A vinyl seawall has a warranty of between 35 and 50 years (concrete typically has no warranty other than a year on workmanship); vinyl will not warp or fade over time; it handles hurricanes and storm surge well, especially when placed in front of the existing concrete (as is usual and typical), and installation time is about the same.

In an era of increasing environmental concern, says Bernice, vinyl is perfect because it doesn't decompose.

Vinyl is maintenance free, unlike concrete's seams that degrade), barnacles have a harder time clinging to the surface, and aesthetically vinyl is simply more pleasing.

When you call the company, point man is Bryan Russell - who has decades of experience in marine

Bryan will explain the technicalities, such as how the tough vinyl sheets interlock and are sunk deeper than the concrete counterparts.

He's also an expert on all the other facets of Imperial Marine's services, and notes too that extended "land decks" are becoming increasingly popular with waterfront dwellers on Marco.

"They add more living space," Bryan says. "They tie everything in, and it looks really clean."







## Visit Everglades National Park

The Everglades National Park covers more than 1.5 million acres in South Florida. While most of the park is remote and inaccessible, there are plenty of spots within a few minutes of Miami and Naples, where you can get a feel for the "River of Grass."

If you want the opportunity to observe the heart of the Everglades, you can enter through Shark Valley in Miami or the Main Entrance of the Park in Homestead. However, if you are looking to explore the Gulf Coast, then you should plan to take a boat trip at the Gulf Coast in Everglades City.

At Royal Palm and Flamingo in Homestead, our main park entrance boasts wildlife that varies from fresh to saltwater species with many trails, campgrounds, and picnic areas along the way. At Everglades City, the Gulf Coast Visitor Center is the park's western saltwater getaway. Narrated boat tours explore pristine Ten Thousand Islands and coastal mangrove. At Shark Valley, the wildlife-viewing tram tour through sawgrass prairie includes a stop at a 65-foot tower for spectacular views.

#### • Shark Valley (Miami)

October 2023

Named because its water flows southwest toward Shark River, Shark Valley is the heartland of the Everglades. At Shark Valley you can walk, bike, or ride a tram along a 15-mile loop road and see some of the park's best wildlife concentrations. The Shark Valley observation tower offers a 360 degree view of the Everglades. The viewing deck overlooks a life-filled water hole, providing a bird's eye view of alligators, turtles, fish, and birds. Tram tours and bicycle rentals are available through Shark Valley Tram Tours. Hours of Operation (Every Day) Visitor Center:



9AM-5PM. Shark Valley Tram Tours: 8:30AM-6PM. Parking Gate & Lot: 8:30AM -6PM. 305-242-7700.

#### Gulf Coast (Everglades City)

From the Gulf Coast Visitor Center in the town of Everglades City, take a boat - your own or a scheduled sightseeing boat tour - to explore the vast mangrove estuary of the Ten Thousand Islands. Boat tours are available through Everglades Florida Adventures. Activities: Boat Tours of the Back Country, Kayaking, Canoeing, Fishing, Biking, and Hiking. Lodging: Houseboats, Eco Tents, Camping, and RV sites. The entry fee to Everglades National Park is \$30 (per vehicle). Refer to www.nps.gov for additional information. 855-793-5542.

Along the Main Park Road in Homestead, which connects our south entrances, there are a series of stops with short walks that show the Everglades' diverse ecosystems.

#### Royal Palm (Homestead)

Royal Palm is the departure point for two interpretive walks: the Anhinga Trail and the Gumbo Limbo Trail. Expect to see plenty of wildlife along the Anhinga Trail, a world famous



boardwalk trail bordering Taylor Slough. The Gumbo Limbo Trail is a paved path through a hardwood hammock. On your car ride to Flamingo, there are many trails to explore off the main park road. Ernest F. Coe Visitor Center Hours: 9AM-5PM (April through Mid-December); 8AM-5PM (Mid-December through March). Bookstore Hours: 9:30AM-4:30PM daily. 305-242-7700.

Royal Palm Information Station and Bookstore: Ranger-led walks and talks are conducted here. The visitor center here includes a small bookstore, restrooms and vending machines. Bookstore Hours: 10AM-4PM daily. 305-242-7237.

#### • Flamingo (38 miles south of the Main Park Entrance in Homestead) At the end of the park road, Flamingo is the gateway to Florida Bay. The bay and

its adjoining maze of mangrove waterways provide homes for thousands of birds and a wealth of fish, crabs, shrimp, and other marine life. Facilities, products, and services at Flamingo include a campground, a marina with boat launching areas, and hiking and canoe trails. 

### **Children Sent Via Parcel Post!**

In 1913, the US Postal Service introduced parcel post service. Customers took advantage of the new expanded regulations to mail things like eggs, live bees, harmless live animals, produce, and even an entire building, one brick at a time. The most unusual deliveries occurred between 1910 and 1920, as numerous customers mailed children via parcel post. In 1920, this practice was officially banned.

Initially, sending children through the mail only occurred with rural carriers, wellknown by the families, sent their precious packages. But as the practice extended, some children traveled greater distances.

In 1914, the San Francisco Examiner published tongue-in-cheek instructions about how mail clerks should care for their special deliveries. Immigration officials sometimes used parcel post services to reunite immigrant

The first attempts to stop the practice of mailing children came in 1914 when mail

officials in Montana said they would no longer accept "parcels of humanity." Postal officials across the country began refusing to accept children in parcel post. Some incurred the wrath of angry parents who demanded the right to mail their children. The price of postage was a lot less than a train ticket. Finally in 1920, the Postmaster General ruled that children could no longer be sent through the mail.







## The Most Flavorful Chicken Thighs Ever

Rub skin-on chicken thighs in a combination of mayonnaise and onion soup mix for a simple chicken dinner full of crunch and tangy flavor.

### **Ingredients:**

• 1 medium yellow onion

• 4 bone-in, skin-on chicken thighs

(about 2 pounds)

• 1 teaspoon kosher salt

• 1/2 cup mayonnaise

• 1 (1-ounce) envelope onion soup mix • 3 tablespoons apple cider vinegar, divided

• 1 teaspoon chicken bouillon

• 1 medium bunch fresh chives • 1/2 cup plain Greek yogurt

cut into 1-inch thick wedges.

• 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper Arrange a rack in the middle of the oven and heat the oven to 400 F. Halve 1 medium yellow onion, then

Season 4 bone-in, skin-on chicken thighs with 1 teaspoon kosher salt. Place skin-side down in an unheated large cast iron skillet. Place over medium-high heat and sear undisturbed until the chicken skin is golden brown and releases easily from the pan, about

Flip the chicken and sear until browned on the second side, about 5 minutes. Meanwhile, place 1/2 cup mayonnaise in a small bowl, add 1 envelope onion soup mix, and stir to combine.

Transfer the chicken to a plate. Add the onion wedges to the pan and cook, trying to keep them

intact as much as possible, until light golden brown on both sides, about 2 1/2 minutes per side.

Add 2 tablespoons of the apple cider vinegar and 1 teaspoon chicken bouillon paste and scrape up any browned bits from the bottom of the pan with a wooden spoon. Turn off the heat.

Dollop 1 tablespoon of the mayonnaise mixture onto each piece of chicken and spread all over with the back of a spoon. Return the chicken skin-side up to the pan, moving the onions around as needed so they aren't covered by the chicken.

Transfer the pan to the oven and roast until the internal temperature of the thickest part of the chicken not touching bone registers at least 165 F on an instant-read thermometer, about 20 minutes. Meanwhile finely chop 1 medium bunch fresh chives until you have 3 tablespoons. Add 2 tablespoons of the chives and 1/2 cup Greek yogurt to the remaining mayonnaise mixture and stir to combine.

When the chicken is ready, if you'd like a bit more color and crunch, turn the oven to broil and broil until well browned and the skin is crisp, about 2 minutes.

Transfer the chicken to a plate. Add the remaining 1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar and 1/2 teaspoon black pepper to the pan and scrape up the browned bits from the bottom with the wooden



Spread the yogurt mixture onto a large plate. Top the yogurt mixture with the onions and chicken. Pour the drippings in the pan over the chicken. Sprinkle with the remaining 1 tablespoon chives.
