










Help Captain Pat Fish Again...





This is because construction must be done from the waterside, and because of staging issues caused by fewer and fewer vacant lots being available for this purpose on the island.

A vinyl seawall has a warranty of between 35 and 50 years (concrete typically has no warranty other than a year on workmanship); vinyl will not warp or fade over time; it handles hurricanes and storm surge well, especially when placed in front of the existing concrete (as is usual and typical), and installation time is about the same.

In an era of increasing environmental concern, says Bernice, vinyl is perfect because it doesn't decompose.

Vinyl is maintenance free, unlike concrete's seams that degrade), barnacles have a harder time clinging to the surface, and aesthetically vinyl is simply more pleasing.

When you call the company, point man is Bryan Russell - who has decades of experience in marine

Bryan will explain the technicalities, such as how the tough vinyl sheets interlock and are sunk deeper than the concrete counterparts.

Prepare for Hurricane Season!

Tallahassee, *Fla.* – Hurricane season has begun, and the Florida Department of Health (Department) is joining the Florida Division of Emergency Management in encouraging all residents and visitors to prepare for severe weather emergencies. Determine any risks to your home, property, or business, and update your emergency plans and supplies before Florida is threatened by a storm. It is important to stay prepared before and after a storm.

Make a Plan

It is essential that individuals have a plan before a disaster occurs. Following an emergency or disaster, you may lose access to basic services, such as power and water, and be subject to limited or no access to essentials like food and water. Visit the Florida Department of Emergency Management "Plan and Prepare" webpage for guidance on making an emergency plan for your family or business.

Make a Kit

As we stay on the lookout for upcoming storms, think about what to keep on hand in order to be prepared. The Florida Division of Emergency Management recommends that you maintain a well-stocked emergency preparedness kit to last you and your family for a minimum of seven days. Each individual or family disaster supply kit differs based on personal needs.

• Water: Enough for drinking, cooking and sanitation purposes—pack a minimum of 1 gallon daily per person for 7 days.

- Food: Non-perishable packaged or canned food and juices, snacks and foods for those with dietary restrictions.
- Cooking Supplies: Manual can opener, cooking tools and fuel, paper plates, and plastic utensils.
- Flashlight and Extra Batteries
- Pillows, Blankets and/or Sleeping Bags

- Clothing: Complete change of clothes suitable for the current climate, sturdy shoes to protect feet from debris or other sharp objects post-storm.
- First Aid Kit, Prescription Medication, and Other Medicines: Include a first aid kit and plan to bring medications that you need. After a storm, you may have limited supplies of your prescription medications and your local pharmacy may close.
- Radio: Battery operated and NOAA weather radio.
- Toiletries
- Cleaning Supplies: Garbage bags, moisture wipes and other items.
- Cash: Banks & ATMs may not be open or available for extended periods.
- Important Documents: Store all critical documents in a waterproof container and save eleconically.
- Contact List: Keep an updated list of all important contacts, including doctors, friends, relatives, out-of-state friends, or relatives.
- Special Items: Assess all family member needs.
- Pet Care Items: Proper identification, immunization records, ample supply of food and water, carrier or cage, medications, muzzle and leash, and a photo of you and your pet together to validate ownership.

Know Where to Find Shelter

You must have: Photo ID, Insurance card, List of emergency contacts, Your primary care provider's contact information.

The time may arise when you may need to evacuate your home to go to a safer place. A hurricane evacuation shelter is a refuge of last resort; a place to go if you are not able to evacuate to a hotel or the home of a relative, friend, or co-worker. Hurricane shelters are also available for people who have no other place to go. The Florida Division of Emergency Management maintains a list of open shelters on their website.

If you know or care for an individual with a disability or special need, such as a medical condition that requires assistance but not hospitalization, you should pre-register with the Florida Special Needs Shelter Registry. Registering through the Florida Special Needs Registry allows local emergency management officials to provide important information and quickly assist you during an emergency. For more information, call your county's emergency management office or visit the Florida Special Needs Registry at https://snr.flhealthresponse.com/.



As hundreds of fires continue to rage in Canada, air quality drops to

unhealthy levels across U.S. states. Satellites have seen smoke from the wildfires gathering over the midwestern United States just days after space-based imagery spotted smoke creeping across the Atlantic into Europe.

Because the smoke is higher in the atmosphere over the European countries affected, people in those countries are unlikely to experience the same hazardous conditions arising in Canada and the U.S. The only break much of America can hope for anytime soon from eye-wa-

tering dangerous smoke is brief bouts of shirt-soaking sweltering heat and humidity from a southern heat wave that has already proven deadly, forecasters say. And then the smoke will likely come back to the Midwest and East.

That's because neither the 235 out-of-control Canadian wildfires nor the stuck weather pattern that's responsible for this mess of meteorological maladies are showing signs of relenting for the next week or longer, according to meteorologists at the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Weather Prediction Center.

First, the stuck weather pattern made abnormally hot and dry conditions for Canada to burn at off-the-chart record levels. Then it created a setup where the only relief comes when low pressure systems roll through, which means areas on one side get smoky air from the north and the other gets sweltering air from the south.

Nearly every province in Canada has fires burning. A record 30,000 square miles (80,000 square kilometers) have burned, an area nearly as large as South Carolina, according to the Canadian government.

And fire season usually doesn't really get going until July in Canada. Hotter than normal and drier air made for ideal fire weather. Warmer weather from climate change means the atmosphere sucks more moisture out of plants, making them more likely to catch fire, and burn faster and hotter.

Where there's fire, there's smoke. Both high heat and smoky conditions are stressors on the body and can present potential challenges to human health.

While the haze of wildfire smoke provides a visual cue to stay inside, there can be hidden dangers of breathing in harmful pollutants such as ozone even when the sky looks clear. There are air chemistry changes that can happen downwind of wildfire smoke, which may have additional and less well-understood impacts on the body.

The seasonal forecast for the rest of the summer in Canada "is for hot and mostly dry" and that's not good for dousing fires.

Prevent Mosquito-Borne Illness

There are cases of West Nile and other viruses every year. Mosquito control efforts focus on managing the mosquitoes that carry this virus, and surveillance is conducted which allows the ability to watch the incidence of positive mosquitoes increase as the temperature increases. West Nile typically begins with birds and can be observed as it moves into the biting Culex populations and on to horses and then humans.

Immediately following a storm, flooding may occur. Mosquito eggs laid in the soil during previous floods can hatch and result in very large populations. Most of these mosquitoes are considered nuisance mosquitoes, however it's essential to protect yourself and your family from mosquito breeding and mosquito-borne illness.

The risk of disease transmission through bites of infected mosquitoes to humans often increases during the warm, rainy months. To protect against mosquitoes, the Department urges the public to "Drain and Cover:"

DRAIN standing water to stop mosquitoes from multiplying:

- Drain water from garbage cans, buckets, pool covers, coolers, toys, flowerpots or any other containers where sprinkler or rainwater has collected.
- Discard old tires, drums, bottles, cans, pots and pans, broken appliances and other items that aren't being used.
- Empty and clean birdbaths and pet's water bowls at least once a week.
- Protect boats and vehicles from rain with tarps that don't accumulate

• Maintain swimming pools in good condition and appropriately chlorinated. Empty plastic swimming pools when not in use.

COVER your skin with clothing or repellent to reduce mosquito bites:

- Clothing If you must be outside when mosquitoes are active, cover up. Wear shoes, socks, long pants and long sleeves.
- Repellent Apply mosquito repellent to bare skin and clothing. Always use repellents according to the label. Repellents with DEET, picaridin, oil of lemon eucalyptus, and IR3535 are effective.
- Use mosquito netting to protect children younger than 2 months old.

COVER doors and windows with screens to keep mosquitoes out of your

home. Repair broken screening on windows, doors, porches and patios.

Tips on Eliminating Mosquito Breeding Sites:





Florida Homeowner **Captures Invasive Cane Toads**

NAPLES - Lee Smith, a Florida homeowner, has taken it upon himself to embark on a relentless mission to hunt down dozens of cane toads in his neighborhood. His actions are motivated by the potential harm these invasive species pose to both people and

The toad eradication endeavor began when Smith's wife experienced sleepless nights due to the cacophony created by the loud noises emanating from the cane toads. Determined



to alleviate the problem, Smith decided to intervene.

"I thought I'm just gonna go out there and see if I can catch 'em," Smith

Within a mere 15 minutes, Smith managed to capture an astonishing 30 to 40 toads in his backyard alone.

"And I thought this is a good way to get rid of cane toads, to just go out and catch 'em. That's how it started, and now it's been like a challenge," Smith

However, Smith's objective doesn't end with the capture. Cane toads are considered an invasive species in Florida, and the Florida Fish and Wildlife officials actually encourage their elimination, but through humane methods.

"I use the refrigerator to first sort of numb 'em, and then they go in the freezer," Smith explained. When asked about their final destination, Smith clarified, "They go in the

dumpster and to waste management." The need for such drastic measures arises from the fact that cane toads not

only invade the ecosystem but also pose a serious threat to pets. According to Dave Feenan from the Humane Society of Naples, "A fullgrown toad can kill a full-grown dog within half an hour. They emit a toxin when a dog bites it or licks it, and it's very dangerous.'

Smith is grateful that his newfound hobby can contribute positively to the community and protect their furry companions. Equally content is his wife,

Denise Smith, who can finally enjoy peaceful nights of sleep without the disruptive noise.

Smith's commitment to this cause is evident from his past accomplishments. Two years ago, he managed to catch approximately 700 cane toads, and last year, his tally surpassed a thousand.




The cane toad (also known as the bufo, giant or marine toad) is a large, nonnative amphibian that has been introduced into Florida. Cane toads are considered an invasive species and are poisonous to most animals that try to bite or consume them. Cane toads are not protected in Florida except by anti-cruelty law and can be removed from private property and humanely killed year-round with landowner permission. Captured cane toads may not be relocated and released

Cane toads are reddish-brown to grayish-brown with a light-yellow or beige belly and can be uniform in color or have darker markings around the body. They have enlarged glands behind the eyes, which angle downward onto the shoulders. The glands secrete a potent milky-white toxin (bufotoxin) as defense against predators including domestic pets.

Cane toads generally range in size from 6 to 9 inches in length. They can be confused with the native southern toad, however, adult cane toads are much larger than adult southern toads which only grow to a maximum of approximately 3 to 4 inches.
